After considerable discussion at a specially called meeting of the congregation last Sunday, the **congregation approved proceeding with construction** on the junior and senior high classroom project and approved funding the entire proposed cost through the Mary Larson Gift Fund. After hearing the alternatives presented by Mike Peters, co chair of the committee, Rainbow agreed by a near unanimous vote to proceed with the project. We want to thank all who helped get this project started and pray for an on time completion with a minimum of delays.
