SILENT AN	ID SPOKEN MEDITATION ON SCRIPTURE***	
Seeker:	God, you have shown us wondrous things. You brought your people out of captivity and provided for them over and over again but today we seem so far from you. We want to feel your presence. Can you still reach us?	
Reader:	The Lord sought to make a new covenant with the people; a covenant so strong that it would be part of their very being. It would be a covenant written on their hearts. Everyone could know the Lord from the most powerful to the least.	
Cong:	The encircling love of God has no beginning or end; neither start nor finish. It is as deep as the need.	
Seeker:	God, you said that you, yourself would live among us and that the death of your Son would fulfill the covenant. Why would you make that sacrifice? Why would his suffering be a part of our redemption? This is both hard to accept and to understand.
