MCC School Kits: School supplies are inexpensive and easy to find at this time of year, so take the opportunity to fill a few Mennonite Central Committee school kits the next time you're at the store. Cloth bags and supply lists are available outside the west entry to the Sanctuary. Please return the completed bags to the church by September 1 and they will be delivered to MCC in North Newton. They are given to students displaced by natural disasters or war or struggling to afford schooling. Last year more than 125,000 kits were sent to children in countries such as Jordan, Iraq, Syria, Ethiopia, Serbia, Lebanon, Ukraine, Haiti and El Salvador.

The contents of each kit are:

- 4 spiral or perforated notebooks (8.5" x 10.5" and 70 sheets)
- 8 unsharpened pencils
- 1 ruler (flat, flexible plastic; indicating both 30 cm and 12 in)
- 12 colored pencils (in packaging)
- 1 large pencil eraser

Rainbow Freedom School's 2015 program has been a success! Last week there were two special events that happened. Over 100 Freedom School scholars, parents, persons from Rainbow Mennonite and other community members participated in the **Kansas Kids' March** on July 14. The group marched along SW Blvd and had a short rally. The focus was on ending child poverty through an increase in school funding and raising the state minimum wage.

Then on July 18, we had another successful **Healthy Kids Healthy Planet Festival** in Whitmore Park. The parents of Freedom School scholars partnered with StoneLion Puppet Theater and Project Central to organize a festival celebrating Healthy Kids and promoting a Healthy Planet. Although it rained off and on, more than 150 people attended and enjoyed the games, puppets, entertainers, dancing, art projects, face painters, and delicious food prepared by the parents. It was a fun event for the community and over \$1000 was raised for Freedom School.

Over 200 people attended the **Freedom School Finale** on July 23 at the Vox Theatre. Thanks to all who attended!
