Our Fall worship series, *Voices of Conscience*, is inspired by a traveling exhibit on peacemaking that will premiere at the National WWI Museum in October and then come to Rainbow for the week of October 23-29. See today's insert for more information. Leading up to this important event, we will spend time in worship reflecting what a Jesus-shaped conscience might sound and look like today.

In recognition of the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the "war to end all wars," the National World War I Museum in Kansas City is hosting a symposium on resistance and conscientious objection leading up to and during WWI. "Remembering Muted Voices" is Oct. 19-22 and explores the whole range of people who objected to and resisted WWI, from religious persons to socialists to suffragists. Registration is \$125, with \$99 early bird registration available through Sept. 8.

## **Fall Sunday School**

New Adult Education classes begin on Sunday, September 10. Please find copies of the class descriptions in the east and west foyers.

Children and youth in grades preschool to 12th grade will begin Sunday School on Sunday, September 10th. Worship Arts will also begin on Sunday, September 10th for Kindergarten - 5th grade students. During the Sunday School hour children and youth will have a featured discussion about *Safe Boundaries* that will be led by school teachers, social workers, and medical persons from within the congregation. Regular SS classes will resume on Sunday, September 17th.

Safe Sanctuary training will be offered two more times this fall: September 10th at 10:50am, and September 17th at 8:30am. This training is required for anyone working with children or youth (Sunday School teachers, sponsors, mentors, nursery and worship arts volunteers), church council, and deacons. This training is highly recommended for anyone in the congregation as we all interact with children and youth on a regular basis. The purpose of the training is to become knowledgeable of the recently updated Abuse Prevention policy, discuss different ways to appropriately interact with one another, understand the plans in place to keep everyone safe, and learn the necessary steps to take in the event of an incident.
