This Morning at Rainbow...

Today is the second Sunday in Lent. Over this 40 day period of repentance and renewal, we will have opportunities to journey with Jesus, who long ago approached Jerusalem and wept, saying, "If you, even you, had only recognized on this day the things that make for peace." (Luke 19:41-42) Thank you to Seth Campbell for creating and donating the origami cranes, which have become a symbol of peace in our modern world. Also front and center is the Mennonite Church USA Peace Lamp. This lamp is a replica of the Peace Lamp given to the President of Iran by a delegation of American religious leaders in 2007. This Peace Lamp will burn throughout season of Lent calling us to express our hope for Peace through ongoing action and prayer.

During the Season of Lent...

The Worship Committee will host early evening prayer services, known as Vespers, on Wednesdays at 6:00pm. A baked potato bar will be available beginning at 5:45. Anyone attending the prayer service is welcome to stay for potatoes afterwards. Suggested meal donation: \$5 or maximum \$15 per family.
