Stewardship Update: We finished the month of October about \$5K above our bottom line budget. Much of the reason that we are ahead at this point is due to liability and health insurance coming in under budget. Contributions have slowed quite a bit during October and the first two Sundays of November and are \$11K below budget going into November. In order to meet our 2018 budget commitment, it is estimated that we will need \$115K in contributions in the final 7 weeks of the year, about \$16.5K per week. Please keep church finances in mind as we head toward the end of our business year.

Note from the Treasurer, Mark Unruh: To all committees, please make sure that you go over your budget requirements in your November meetings. 2019 budget requests are due back to Stewardship Committee by December 1.
