Highlights through the end of May:

- 2018 revenues are about 4% under budget, and about \$8.2K behind our revenues at the same point in 2018.
 - Much of this revenue shortfall was caused by weak contributions in May, which were around \$12,000 under budget.
 - YTD contributions as of 5/31 were \$152,295, which is roughly 34% of of our annual 2019 contributions budget of \$453,016.
 - Head Start recently informed us that they will not be renewing their lease for the 2019-2020 school year, due to a loss of grant funding. This will result in a \$6,000 budget shortfall in rental income for 2019.
- 2019 expenses were significantly below budget as of 5/31, and also behind where we were at this point in 2018.
 - Shortfalls on the expense side were caused primarily by lower than budgeted spending on electricity, park maintenance, building maintenance, peace and social justice, and educational expenses.
- Net Income is \$4K compared to a \$9.8K budgeted loss through May. Our Net Income is \$1.5K behind where we were at the same point in 2018.
- Cash in the bank remains in a very healthy position.
- Our mortgage balance has been reduced by \$31.3K in the past twelve months.
- The Rainbow Mennonite Church Endowment Fund is at \$92.1K, an increase of \$30K over the balance at this time last year.
