Note about VT 571, O God, We Read the Holy Law:

For churches in some traditions, the last Sunday in October is recognized as Reformation Sunday, a Sunday to remember the events that led to the beginning of the Protestant Church. One of the leaders of the Reformation movement, Martin Luther, was also a musician and wrote this melody. Although the straightforward metrical version of this melody may be more familiar, this rhythmic version is actually the original. The text for #571 is by Michael Schneider, one of the early Swiss Mennonites, and was first published in 1564 in one of the first Anabaptist hymnals. In both text and tune this hymn offers a connection to the earliest Protestant/Anabaptist expressions of worship.
